The International Society for Weigh-In-Motion (ISWIM) is an international non-profit organization, founded in 2007, legally based in Switzerland. It is an international network of and for people and organisations active in the field of Weigh-In-Motion. One of our purposes is to support advances in and the more widespread use of Weigh-In-Motion technologies and the applications of WIM data. This we do through the organization of regional seminars every year and the International Conference on WIM (ICWIM) every couple of years. Currently ISWIM has 700 individual members from 70 countries and all continents, and 25 WIM vendors and consultants as corporate members.

ISWIM Young Researcher Award

Every year, ISWIM offers scholarships to bachelor, master and PhD students, or post docs up to five years after graduation working on WIM-related research projects. Participants must demonstrate a passion for WIM through either their studies or early professional life and show “substantial evidence” of their research. “Substantial evidence” could be an original contribution in the form of a journal or conference paper; a report; or a series of presentations that clearly defines the scope of the project, technical approach, and anticipated or final conclusion(s).

Application

In 2021 ISWIM will fully sponsor the travel and registration expenses for recipients to present their work at the 3rd ISWIM Regional Seminar in Pretoria, South-Africa¹. Sponsorship from ISWIM will not exceed 2000 Euro. Applicants should send their CV, two reference letters, and an abstract up to 1000 words with supporting “substantial evidence” of their work. Submissions should be emailed to Lily Poulidakos at lily.poulidakos@empa.ch. This year’s deadline is extended to April 30th and the award winners will be announced mid 2021.
